Students, except for those with AP or IB credit or college credit, are initially placed into the math courses using the following schedule:

Math Index < 880:	placement is MAT 095
$880 \leq$ Math Index < 980:	placement is MAT 131/MAT 133
$980 \leq$ math Index:	placement is MAT 191

All business students are required to pass or place out of MAT 131/133 Pre-calculus. All finance and economics majors are required to pass MAT 191 Calculus I.

Students who are dissatisfied with their placement may take the Mathematics Placement Test to determine whether they may move up to a higher-level course. A score of 11 or higher places the student into MAT 133. A score of 15 or higher places the student into MAT 191.
